

# The Tax Increase Prevention Act of 2014

## Proof of <u>Qualified Energy Property</u> for Claiming Tax Credits for Residential Heating & Cooling Equipment

The U.S. Internal Revenue Service (IRS) is now providing Consumers with a tax credit on high-efficiency heating and cooling equipment. Rheem Sales Company, Inc. (Manufacturer of *Sure Comfort* (Confort) certifies that the following models (if placed in service after December 31, 2013 and before January 1, 2015 in a homeowner's primary residence) meet the criteria of "Qualified Energy Property" as set forth by Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code.
